

The Hindu culture promotes love, respect, honouring others and humbling one's own ego so that the inner nature, which is naturally pure and modest, will shine forth. Hinduism is an ancient philosophy and a way of life that includes an advanced system of ethics, meaningful rituals, practices, traditions and beliefs. It is rooted in prehistoric Vedic culture and draws on a common system of Dharmic values. These values advocate charity, harmony, moral wellbeing and the universal betterment of humanity.

Practice of Hindu culture in Australia is on the increase and is the fast growing according to the Australian census. The Gold Coast Hindu Cultural Association, based in one of the fastest growing regions of Australia, aims to promote Hindu culture, education of Hindu philosophy and classical languages among the community by being inclusive and supportive of friendship, respect, peace and tolerance. In particular, the not-for-profit association will strive to promote and foster Hindu cultural activities, classical literature, music, dance and spiritual education by providing resources and facilities at the proposed "Hindu Education and Cultural Centre".

The Gold Coast Hindu Cultural Association Inc was founded in 2012 by members from Hindu Community who saw the urgent need to serve and support the cultural, educational, spiritual and moral well-being of the South East Queensland region's rapidly growing Hindu population.

The Gold Coast Hindu Cultural Association has the following noble objects:

Culture

- To promote and foster classical dance, music, performing art, literature, Indian visual art and craft.
- To organise and conduct regular classes for various performing art forms, classical dance and literature.
- To acquire, construct and maintain a Hindu Cultural Center to facilitate the above activities.
- To organise workshops and seminars as appropriate to promote the above objects.
- o To organize publications for dissemination of knowledge.

Education

- To promote the learning of Hindu philosophy, Saivam, classical languages and educational values of Hindu culture and Hindu Religion both in terms of theory and practice.
- To organise and conduct regular classes, workshops and other appropriate learning activities for teaching the above.
- To organise and conduct appropriate assessments to evaluate the learning outcomes.
- To promote and facilitate research and educational activities related to Hindu culture, architecture and heritage.
- o To acquire, construct and maintain a Hindu Education Centre for imparting knowledge and practical training for kids, youth and adults.
- To organise conferences and exhibitions with the assistance of scholars in these fields.

· Hindu Rituals

 To provide a forum and/or facilities for the worship and practice of religious activities and Hindu rituals and to foster the Hindu way of life.

Background

GCHCA has gone through a number of historical stages of development. The Hindu community in South East Queensland had long expressed a desire to set up a Hindu Education precinct in Gold Coast. There was a strong expression of interest for such a project to bring all Hindu functions, rituals, cultural activities and education under one roof in South East Queensland. This vibrant community regularly celebrates various cultural and religious functions enthusiastically that brings to live the Hindu culture in South East Queensland whenever and wherever possible. There are regular functions (e.g Dewali and Saraswathy poojas), bajans, ethnic language education classes and other cultural activities, which make this possible. For example, After Hour Ethnic Language School for Tamil was started in Gold Coast in September 2006 in a house in Biggera Waters. Gold Coast devotees started April New Year Annathanam in Sri Selva Vinayagar Kovil in South Mclean. In May 2008, regular Bhajan started in a house in Varsity Lakes.

Finally, on Friday, 18 November 2011, after the monthly Bhajan, the community met and decided to act on the wishes of the wider Hindu community. The community decided that a committee be set up to explore the feasibility of setting up a Hindu cultural precinct in Gold Coast. The exploratory committee was accordingly set up. This committee made recommendations on how to move forward including the creation of an interim committee with specific tasks, which included setting up of a legal entity and creation of a strong constitution for the organization. The community met again after Bhajan on February 17th 2012 and an interim committee was unanimously elected to act on the recommendations of the exploratory committee. They conducted numerous consultations with the wider community and updated the community in a town hall like meetings after regular Bhajans. With the input from range of experts and interest groups, and extensive consultation process the interim committee drafted a strong and visionary constitution. They organized the inaugural AGM of the newly formed association, "The Gold Coast Hindu Cultural Association" on 17th Aug 2012 at which the first management committee was unanimously elected.

With divine providence, on 17th August 2012 GCHCA has been generously offered a prime land by the Gold Coast City Council to establish a 'Gold Coast Hindu Education and Cultural Precinct' in Byth Street, Arundel.

The GCHCA was then incorporated in Queensland on 13th of September 2012. The association received Tax Concession Charity (TCC) status and FBT Rebate from ATO. The GCHCA building donation account received the Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status on 23rd Nov 2012. One of the best endorsements for any community organisations from the Federal Government is the DGR status. This was another milestone for the Association towards achieving its noble objects. The Association also received the Certificate of Registration as a Queensland Charity on 6th Dec 2012. The GCHCA had their 2nd AGM on September 2013 with 46 Founder Members and two Life Members.

Once again with extensive consultation with the wider community through town hall meetings, print and electronic media the Management Committee developed a Master Plan for the 'Hindu Education and Cultural Precinct'. With numerous discussions with the Gold Coast City Council the master plan for the precinct received the Development Approval (DA) on 2nd Feb 2015. A large number of professionals have given their voluntary services to the successful DA application. A detailed design for the Building Application is now underway. To date the Association has achieved all these progress mainly with the enormous help of large number of volunteers in Queensland and Inter-State.

Hindu Educational and Cultural Precinct

To achieve the objectives GCHCA has designed a Hindu education and cultural precinct in Gold Coast. The Hindu community in Gold Coast, Brisbane and Northern New South Wales have welcomed this innovative design. The precinct will include a place of worship for Hindus as well as a cultural hall.

Within a relatively short period, the association has already raised over \$550,000 and continues to be bestowed with donations. Members of the community have also generously pledged donations and loans of a further \$400,000. However, the association is still far from achieving its target and the GCHCA needs your urgent support to fulfil its noble objectives with minimal impediments.

We therefore humbly appeal for your support and become a member of the Association. Any contribution would make a difference and every cent counts towards helping our community realize its dream. While we empathise that not everyone would be in a position to make substantial cash contributions, we urge you to spread the good word and encourage your friends and relatives to support our united mission. 




नवरात्रि पर्व आदिशक्ति मातेश्वरी दुर्गा का पराकर्म, शौर्य और कृपा का पर्व है। यही शिवशक्ति स्वरूपा भगवती माता देवताओंकी स्तुति से प्रसन्न हो बलशाली अत्याचारी असुरों का संहार कर विभिन्न नामों से विश्व में प्रसिद्ध हुई। भगवती दुर्गा श्रद्धा भक्ति से स्तुति करने पर अपने भक्तजनों के समस्त संकटो को दूर करती हैं। नव देवियो के रूप में प्रसिद्ध माँ की उपासना तैत तथा अश्विन (क्वार) के महीनों में नव दिनों तक विशेष रूप से बडी भक्तिभाव से की जाती है।

सर्वेश्वरी माता दूर्गा की विविध लीलाओं का वर्णन मार्कण्ये पुराण, देवी भागवत तथा श्री दुर्गा सप्तशती आदि ग्रन्थों में पाया जाता है ।

माँ दुर्गा अपने प्रथम स्वरूप में "शैलपुत्री" के नाम से जानी जाती हैं। दूसरा स्वरूप "ब्रह्मचारिणी" तीसरी शक्ति का नाम "चन्द्रधन्टा"। इनका यह स्वरूप परम शान्तिदायक और कल्याणकारी है। "कृष्माण्डा" इनका चौथा स्वरूप है। माँ का पाँचवा स्वरूप "स्कन्दमाता" कहलाती है। छठवा स्वरूप "कात्यानी", सातवी शक्ति "कालरात्री", आठवी "महागौरी" और नवी शक्ति का नाम "सिद्धीदात्री" है। नवरात्रि पूजन में सब से उत्तम बात है भगवती दुर्गामाता के चरणों में प्रमपूर्वक भिक्ति।

नव दूर्गांओं में प्रथम शैलपुत्री दूर्गां का महत्व और शक्तियाँ अनन्त है। नवरात्र प्रथम दिवस इन्ही को पूजा ओर उपासना की जाती है। इस वर्ष नवरात्रि पर्व अश्विन मास (October) 14 ता. तिथि पर्तिपदा से आरंभ हो शुक्लपक्ष नवमी तिथि को समाप्त होगा। भक्त प्रसन्न वरदायनी भगवती दुर्गा भक्तजनों की मनोंकामनायें पूर्ण करे। క్వీన్స్ లాండ్ తెలుగు అపోసియేషన్ నుండి, పారేపల్లి సత్యనారాయణ. మీ అందరికి దసరా శుభాకాంక్షలు. సేను భారతదేశం ఆంధ్రప్రదేశ్ లోని, కృష్ణాజిల్లా కోనాయపాలెం అసే గ్రామంలో వ్యవసాయం వృత్తిగా, సామాజిక సేవ ప్రవృత్తిగా కలిగి యున్నాను.

భారతదేశంలోని హిందువుల ముఖ్యమైన పండుగలలో, దసరా పండుగ ఒకటి. ఈ పండుగ ఆశ్వీజ శుద్ధ పాద్యమీ మొదలు, ఆశ్వీజ శుద్ధ దశమీ వరకు జరుపుకుంటారు. నవమీ వరకు దేవీ నవరాత్రులని, పదవరోజు విజయదశమీ అని వ్యవహరిస్తారు. ఈ పండుగ శరత్ కాలములో వస్తుంది కావున, శరత్ నవరాత్రులని కూడా అంటారు. తొమ్మిదరోజులలో చివరి మూడురోజులు దుర్గాష్టమీ, మహర్నవమీ, విజయదశమీ ముఖ్యమైనవి. విద్యార్ధులు పుస్తకాలను, శ్రామికులు రైతులు తమ పరికరాలను, పూర్వం రాజులు అయుధాలను,పూడిస్టారు. ముఖ్యమైన నవరాత్రులలో లక్క్లి, సరస్వతి, పార్వతి, మాతలను ఆరాధిస్తారు. లకీరా అష్టోత్తరాలు, లఠీఠా సహస్థనామాలు చదువుతారు. ప్రజలు ముఖ్యంగా శక్తిపీఠాలలో, అమ్మవారిని దర్శిస్తారు. శక్తి పీఠాలు 18 (అష్టాదశ), అని, 52 అని, 108 అని లెక్కిస్తారు. భారత్ లోని ముఖ్యమైన శక్తిపీఠాలలో, కంచిలోని కామాకి, ఆలంపూర్ లోని జోగులాంట, మైసూరు లోని దాముండీ, శ్రీశైలం లోని భ్రమరాంట, ఉజ్జయినిలోని మహాకాళి, విజయవాడ లోని కనకదుర్గ, కాశి లోని అన్నపూర్ణ, కొల్లాపూర్ లోని మహలక్కి, హిమాచలప్రదేశ్ లోని పైష్టవి, జమ్ములోని సరస్వతి, తమిళనాడులోని కన్యాకుమారి వంటివి ఉన్నాయి. ఇవేకాక శ్రీలంక, పాకిస్థాన్, బంగ్లాదేశ్, నీపాల్ దేశాలలో ఉన్న శక్తిపీఠాలు పూజులందుకుంటున్నాయి. నవరాత్రులలో దేవీ మాతను రోజుకో దేవతగా అలంకరించి పూజులు చేస్తారు. ఈ తొమ్మిది రోజులలో అమ్మవారిని బాలత్రపురసుందరి, గాయత్రి, మహాలక్కీ, ఆన్మపూర్ణ, సరస్వతీ అలంకారాన్ని, చదువుకునే పిల్లలు దర్శించి, ప్రత్యేకంగా పూజులు జరుపుఠారు. 9 రోజులు అమ్మవారికి 9 రకాల సైపేద్యాలు నివేదిస్తారు. కొన్ని ప్రాంతాలో బొమ్మలకొలువులు ఏర్పాటుచేస్తారు.

పదవరోజు పారువేటనే సంప్రదాయమైన క్రీడ జరుపుతారు. పారువేటలో దేవదేవుడు, పేటకు పెళ్లినట్లు అలంకరించి ఉరేగిస్తారు. శమీవుకుం అనబడే జమ్మిచెట్టును అపరాజితా దేవతగా భావిస్తారు. జమ్మిచెట్టును పూజించి, తమకు శుభం కలగాలని కోరుతూ జమ్మిచెట్టు క్రిందచేరి, ఒక కాగితంపై " శమీ శమీ యతే పాపం, శమీ శత్తువినాశనం, అర్జునశ్య ధనుర్దారి, రామస్యప్రేయదర్శనం " అని వ్రాసి చెట్టు కు కట్టి పూజిస్తారు. దీనిసే జమ్మివ్రాతలు అని అంటారు. శమీపుణ అనంతరం పాలపిట్టను చూస్తారు. రాముడు పదితలల రావణుని సంహరించాడని, ఇది పదిరోజుల పండుగనీ , దీనిసే "దస్ హరా" పేరుతో దసరా అని అంటారు. పాండవులు అరణ్యవాసం ముగించి, అజ్ఞాత వాసం పెళ్ళేముందు తమ ఆయధాలను, జమ్మిచెట్టుపై భద్రపరచినట్లు భావిస్తారు. విజయదశమి రోజు, అర్జునుడు ఉత్తరగోగ్రహణం సమయాన, విజయం సాధించినట్లుగా భావిస్తారు. అంతేకాక దుర్గాదేవి మహిషాసురుడనే రాకసునితో, 9 రోజులు యుద్ధంచేసి చంపి, విజయం సాధించినదానికి గుర్తుగా, ఈ పండుగచేస్తారు. దసరాకు క్రొత్త అళ్లుళ్లని పిలవడం, రకరకాల పిండివంటలు, క్రొత్త వస్త్రాలు వంటి పేడుకలు జరుపుకుంటారు. ఆంధ్రప్రదేశ్ లో ముఖ్యంగా తెలంగాడాలో 9 రోజులు ప్రతుకమ్మ పండుగలని, ఆడవారు పేడుకగా జరుపుతారు. తంగేడు, గునుగు, పున్నాగ వంటి పూలను, ఒకపర్గం పై పిరమిడ్ ఆకారంలో పేర్చి, ఒక ఆవరణలో అనేక మంది తెచ్చిన బతుకమ్ములను ఉంచి, వలయాకారంలోనిలచి, పాటలు పాడుతూ, లయబద్ధంగా కదులుతూ, నృత్యాలు చేస్తారు. తొమ్మిది రోజుల పూజ తరువాత, ఊరేగింపుగా తీసుకవెళ్ళి నిమజ్ఞనంచేస్తారు.

గ్రహాలు, తిధులు, నక్షత్రాలు, వారాలు, రోజులు వంటి వాటితో పనిలేకుండా విజయదశమిరోజు తలపెట్టిన పనీ దిగ్విజయంగా జరుతుందని భావిస్తారు. దసరాకు, దసరా వేషాలని వివిధ రాకాల వేషాలు, జంతువులు మరియు దేవతామూర్తుల వంటివి వేస్తారు. "అయ్యవారికి దాలు ఐదువరహాలు, పిల్లవాళ్లకు దాలు పప్పుటెల్లాలు", అని పల్లెలలో పూర్వకాలం చదువుకునే పిల్లలు, అయ్యవార్లు భూస్వాముల ఇండ్లలో, విరాళాలు వసూలుచేస్తారు. దసరా మామూళ్ళు అనే పేరుతో కొంతమంది చందాలు వసూలు చేస్తారు. ఇటువంటివి సేడు కనుమరుగైపోయాయి. మైసూరులో ఏనుగుల ఊరేగింపు, విజయవాడలో భేతాళపేషాలు, గుజరాత్ లో గార్భా మరియు దాండియా నృత్యాలు, టెంగాలులో దేవీ మూర్తులను 9 రోజులు పూజించి నిమజ్జనం, కేరళలో క్రొత్తగా అకరాభ్యాసాలు చేయించడం వంటివి చేస్తారు. ఇంకా ముఖ్యంగా రామలీలా ఉత్సవాలని, విజయదశమి రోజు రావణ, కుంభకర్ణ, మేఘనాద బొమ్మలను తయారు చేసి వాటిలో బాణసందా కూర్చి, రామ లక్ష్మణ పేషధారులతో వాటిని బాణాలతో కొట్టించి దహింపచేస్తారు. ఈ రామలీలా ఉత్సవాలు, దేశ వ్యాప్తంగా అనేక చోట్ల జరుగుతాయి. అనేక మంది ప్రజలు ఈకార్యక్రమంలో పాల్గొంటారు.

పండుగలనేవి ప్రాచీనతను ప్రతిబింబిస్తాయి. పండుగలలోని అంతర్యాన్ని తెలుసుకుని ఆచరిందాలి. మంచిని గ్రహించడం, చెడును విసర్జించడమే పండుగల పరమార్ధం. అదేసమయంలో మూడమైనవి, అసందర్భమైనవి వదలి, సామాజికపరమైన మేలుకూర్పే ఆదారాలను పరిగ్రహించాలి. పండుగలు ప్రతి సంవత్సరం ప్రతిమాసంలో ఒక్కొక్కటి, ఒక్కోతిధి పేరున జరుపుకుంటారు. దైనందిన జీవనంలో ఆటవిడుపు, గృహాలు శుభ్రపరచుకోవడం, నూతన వస్త్రాలు ధరించడం, బందుపులతో కలసిపోవడం, పిండివంటలు ఆరగించడం, తాము నమ్మే దైవాలను ఆరాధించడం సంప్రదాయకమైనవి. నేడు పండుగల పేరుతో అనేక అసాంఘీక కార్యక్రమాలు జరుపుకోవడం దురదృష్టం. పండుగల పేరుతో దందాలు చేయడం, తాగి తందనాలు ఆడడం వంటివి అవాంధనీయం. ప్రతిరోజు అబడ్డాలు ఆడడం, మోసాలు చేయడం, వంచించడం వంటి దుర్మార్గపు పనులు చేసే రామా లేదా కృష్ణా అంటినో, పలాని దేవాలయంలో పూజలు చేస్తే లేదా మొక్కులు తీర్చుకుంటినో, పలానా నదిలో స్నానాలు చేస్తేనో, పాపాలు పోయి ప్రజాళన ఔతారు అనే అసహజమైన, అవాంచనీయమైన నమ్మకాలను వదలి పేయాలి. మనంచేసే పనులను బట్టి ఫలితం ఉంటుంది అనే మహనీయుల మాటలను ఆచరించాలి. తెలియని పరలోకం కంటే తెలిసిన ఇహాలోకంలో, సర్వమానవ పాభ్రాత్వం, మానవసేపే మాధవ సేవ అనే దృక్పథం కఠిగియుండాలి. తెల్లితండ్రుల మాటలను ఆచరించిన రాముడు, దుష్టత్వాన్ని సంహరించిన దేవీమాత లను ఆదర్భంగా తీసుకుని, అందరూ "సర్వజనా సుఖవోధవంతు" అని జీవిందాలి.










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Navratri

Navratri celebrations are filled with traditional music and dance. During Navratri Goddess Durga is worshipped in 9 different forms known as Navdurga. The word Navratri means 'nine nights' in Sanskrit. Navratri is celebrated as the victory of good over evil.

Navratri, or also known as the festival of the 'nine nights' is a Hindu festival devoted to Goddess Durga who symbolizes power and purity. Navratri starts from the 13th of October. During the Navratri festival all devotees of Goddess Durga participate in rituals, puja's and fasting for nine days and nights. The Navratri festival in India takes place in March/April and September/October. During March/April the festival is called 'Chaitra Navratri' and during September/October the festival is called 'Sharad Navratri'.



During Navratri many village people and people from cities perform pujas representing different forms of Goddess Durga, including Goddess Lakshmi and Goddess Saraswati. Chanting of mantras, bhajans and folk songs are included in the puja rituals for nine days during Navratri.
